NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING REGULATIONS

Last week, Bishop Lucia informed us that he was now requiring all those who serve in Liturgical functions in our parishes will have to undergo safe environment certification. This is done by attending a two hour session with a trained member of the diocesan Office of Safe Environment. This means that all lectors, choir members and others (in our parish many of the other roles that fall under this mandate do not exist) will have to get this certification. Once you are certified, you have to renew your certification every five years, by attending a shorter "refresher" class.

There will be a training session on Wed. 19 March at St. Helena's in Sherrill from 6-8 PM. However, you must pre register in order to get into the class. The next one closest to us in our region will be at St. Mary's/St. Peter's in Rome on 2 April from 9:30-11:20 AM. Again, only pre-registered will be admitted to the class.
