THE RED GUARD OF TRADITION

“Who controls the past controls the future. Who controls the present controls the past.” (*George Orwell, 1984*).

Tucker Carlson recently interviewed a Chinese woman named Xi Van Fleet. After Mao Tse Tung's cultural revolution, Xi sought and received asylum in the US in the 1970's. She soon came to love and defend America. This became especially evident in 2020, when she realized the US was undergoing a communist revolution, fabricated not upon a conflict of class, but rather that of race. Although Xi never wanted to become involved in politics in the US, she spoke at a Loudon Co. (VA) school board meeting. This was because she feared the youth of this country were being brainwashed like those of Mao's China in the 1960's. Xi quickly gained a massive following among American conservatives who believe her: America is undergoing a communist-coup.

Xi described how China underwent its own “Defund the Police” when the “Red Guard” students replaced normal law and order in China during Mao's “seizure of power”. Although Mao would eventually disband and betray his own paramilitary students, he originally took these “Red Guards” from the ranks of the rich youth in order to advance his revolution. Mao invented a new, fake history of China, terminating intellectual opposition to his atheism and communism.

Xi Van Fleet explained to Tucker: “In the cultural revolution there is only one correct way of thinking, of talking. If you don't do it, you'll get into trouble.” Mao tried to make himself look like a merciful savior to the rural farmers of China. (They would later perish in the famine-the death toll being between 20 and 50 million).

What does this have to do with the Catholic Church? Keep in mind that Cardinal Suenens (a liberal Belgian cardinal) once declared, “Vatican II is the French Revolution in the Church. And as you know, the French Revolution was the prototype of the errors of Russia, warned about by Our Lady at Fatima. For a successful revolution (economic or liturgical) one's own cultural history has to be undone, forgotten and ultimately replaced by a fake one. Historical amnesia greases the skids for moral revolutions in all matters of State. But apparently this is also true in the Catholic Church hierarchy. Why? Because “the Council” recreated Divine Revelation in so-called “ecumenism”, and then revamped the Church's liturgical history in overhauling not just the Mass, but all seven of the sacraments!!!

Not only was doctrine and liturgy changed over the past 70 years, but the history of the Catholic Church was revamped. From numerous Saints removed from the calendar to the modern myth that “the new Mass is older than the old Mass”. The truth is that all of Catholic history and teaching got overhauled in the minds of most Catholics since the 1960's. Why? So that we might forget our own history and believe in a new one.
