WHICH BIBLE SHOULD YOU READ OR PURCHASE?

A question we are frequently asked. Not every Bible is a reliable translation, even if it says "Catholic", or has an imprimatur! The New American Bible is an example, translated by modernists. The King James version is a Protestant Bible, eliminating 7 books from the Old Testament, and was translated to favor Protestant interpretations.

The classic Catholic English translation is known as the Douay-Rheims translation, Challoner edition. For some this is a bit difficult due to the older English style. The Revised Standard (Catholic edition) is another faithful translation with more "modern" English.
