Four priest exorcists have made an appeal for faithful Catholics to observe this Friday as a day of penance, prayers to the Sacred Heart and the Holy Rosary in reparation for the idolatrous ceremonies conducted last month in the Vatican. They remind us of the words of Sacred Scripture: "The gods of the nations are devils, but the Lord made the heavens", (Ps.95:5) and "I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God", (I Cor. 10:20). Idolatry opens the worshipper up to demonic forces, and now we must do penance in order to drive these evil spirits from the Church.

St. Nicholas is the Patron of children. Bring them to Holy Mass today to be blessed by his relic.

A NOTE ABOUT THE FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

Normally, this Solemnity falls on 8 December, and is a Holy Day of Obligation. This year, because that date falls on a Sunday, according to the norms of the liturgical calendar, the Solemnity is superseded by the II Sunday of Advent. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is transferred to Monday, 9 December, but is not a Holy Day of Obligation. We will offer Holy Mass that day at 7 PM, to honor the Mother of God on her Feast, which is also the patronal feast of our Nation and our Diocese. In the traditional calendar, however, the Feast is NOT displaced by the Sunday, and so the Traditional Latin Mass on 8 December will be the Mass of the Immaculate Conception.
