ONE BRAVE POLISH YOUTH

A picture of a 15-year-old boy standing alone with his crucifix and rosary held high as police in riot gear and LGBT protesters march toward him has gone viral.

The youth is Jakub Baryla, who stood in the middle of a street in Plock, Poland as an “Equality March” paraded down the street toward him. The marchers waved rainbow flags and police in riot gear led the way, but there stood Jakub, holding the Crucifix and Rosary up before them.

The 15-year-old explained that he was inspired by similar gesture made by Fr. Ignacy Skorupko during the 1920 Warsaw battle with the Bolsheviks. He said that he “wanted to give people something to think about and make them reflect”.

In our present age, the threat of transgenderism backed by government sanctioned surgical and hormonal mutilation of children in defiance of their parents' attempts to protect them is very real. State-coerced child gender “transitioning” is already here.

Forced government indoctrination of school children in order to make them more open to questioning their sexuality while undermining their gender identity as either male or female has become totalitarian in nature. Public libraries have become battlegrounds for grooming the smallest of children for transgenderism thanks to the proliferation of Drag Queen Story Hours in western countries.

The worlds of medial, global and national corporations, and even professional sports are part of the juggernaut threatening children and families.

Poland's Jakub Baryla is now an international symbol. His now iconic picture clearly displays the nature of the battle we now face: LGBT ideology seeks to suppress and destroy the influence of Christianity, and it especially hates the Cross of Jesus Christ.

Ironically, as they march for “freedom”, LGBT activists seek to suppress the message of the Cross, the only means through which they might discover true freedom.
