"The sabbath, which represented the completion of the first creation, **has been replaced by Sunday**, which recalls the new creation inaugurated by the Resurrection of Christ." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #2190).

"The Church celebrates the day of Christ's Resurrection on the 'eighth day', Sunday, **which is rightly called the Lord's Day**. (Catechism of the Catholic Church, #2191).

ROSARY CAMPAIGN TO CONVERT GOV. ANDREW CUOMO

THE JOHN PAUL II INSTITUTE VICTIM OF PAPAL WRECKING BALL

The Institute on Marriage and Family, founded by Pope St. John Paul II has been informed that two of its most solid and orthodox pillars have been removed from their positions. Mgr. Livio Melina, who holds the Chair of Fundamental Moral Theology and Fr. Jose Noriega, who holds the Chair of Specialized Moral Theology will no longer be teaching at the Institute. These two men are considered the most faithful to the teaching of Pope John Paul II on life matters and marriage.

This coup has been carried out under the direction of the new Grand Chancellor of the Institute, Archbishop Vincenzo Paglia, and is aimed at implementing the decree of Pope Francis, *Summa Familiae cura*, establishing a new Institute.

Msgr. Melina is the successor of the founding President of the Institute, Cardinal Carlo Caffara. The Cardinal was one of the foremost moral theologians in the Church today, and was an ardent defender of the Church's teaching on moral subjects.

During the time of Msgr. Melina's presidency, the Institute was expanded all across the globe. In the past year, the Institute had 516 students in Rome, and 3200 students across the world in six centers. He also directed the growth of the Institute in moral theology through conferences, publications and international collaboration.

Msgr. Melina also served as an official of the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith for six years. In 2016, he was dismissed as President of the Institute, but continued teaching there his courses on moral theology. He was replaced by Msgr. Pierangelo Sequeri, a musicologist (!!!) and theologian.

There has been much discontent within the newly restructured Institute under Abp. Paglia and Msgr. Sequeri. The comments and recommendations of the faculty were solicited in the preparation of a new constitution for the Institute, and when it was issued, these comments and recommendations had been ignored.

The Italian Catholic agency, *La Nuova Bussola Quotidiana*, states that "The work of destruction, begun with the decree of Pope Francis who created a new Institute entrusted to Msgr. Paglia in the role of Grand Chancellor, is now in a decisive phase with the approval of the new statutes and the new curriculum. Msgr. Melina's days were clearly numbered. It was clear that he was the pillar that had to be knocked out to bring down the whole structure."
