PLEASE TAKE ACTION TO PREVENT THESE BILLS BY NYS & GOVERNOR CUOMO

Once again, our "Catholic" Governor has outdone himself in championing the cause of his god: the devil. He has announced his support to legalize surrogate motherhood contracts in NYS.
