## *ROSARY NOVENA CAMPAIGN FOR THE ELECTION*

Is there anyone among us who is not aware of what is riding on this upcoming election on 3 November? Our nation is leaning over the edge of the precipice. We have already lost so much of our Christian civilization with the legalization of abortion, the widespread acceptance of contraception, the recognition of same sex “marriage”, the pervasive corruption of pornography, and the militant LBGT movement. Do we really want to see more of the same? The remedy and solution is not a political one, it is a spiritual one. We must take up the most powerful and effective weapon God has given us: The Holy Rosary of our Blessed Lady.

Archbishop Carlo Maria Vigano has called for a 54 Day Rosary Novena to the Mother of God for this election. In this Novena, we pray the Holy Rosary each day for 27 days in petition, and for 27 days immediately after in thanksgiving, whether our petition is granted or not. So, we are praying the 15 decades of the rosary (over 3 days) nine times in petition, and the 15 decades of the rosary (over 3 days) nine times in thanksgiving.

The origin of this Novena is the Mother of God herself. In 1884, in Naples, Italy, a young girl by the name of Fortuna Agrelli was suffering from a horrible illness, which caused her severe cramps. On February 16, 1884, the girl and her family began a Rosary Novena to beg Our Lady for a cure. On March 3 of that year, the Blessed Virgin appeared to Fortuna, accompanied by St. Dominic and St. Catherine of Siena. The Blessed Mother held the Christ Child on her lap, and the two of them were dressed in gold-embroidered garments. They were surrounded by luminous figures as they sat on a high throne, surrounded by flowers.

The young lady looked upon the Heavenly Mother, and prayed, “O Queen of the Holy Rosary, be gracious to me; restore me to health! I have already prayed a Novena to you, O Mary, but have not yet experienced your aid. I am anxious to be cured.”

The Mother of God looked with tender pity on her child and said, “Child, you have always invoked me by various titles and have obtained favors from me. Now, you have called upon me by that title, which is so pleasing to me, Queen of the Holy Rosary...Whoever wishes to gain favors from me should make three novenas of the prayers of the Rosary, and three novenas in thanksgiving.”

This is a Novena of love!!!
