Pope Francis and Same-Sex Civil Unions

Once again Pope Francis has shocked and scandalized faithful Catholics with his comments on same-sex civil unions. The comments were made during a documentary that was released on 21 October 2020. In it, the Pope said, “What we have to create is a civil union. In this way, they will be legally covered.” He also said that homosexual couples “have a right to have a family” and that “no one should be thrown out or made unhappy because of it”.

In response to the Pope's remarks, Raymond Cardinal Burke has issued a statement of his own.

His Eminence first of all regrets the confusion and error that such statements cause, as they are contradictory to the teaching of Sacred Scripture, Sacred Tradition, and the Magisterium of the Church. He points out that these comments of the Pope are of no magisterial authority, but his private opinions, pure and simple.

The Cardinal, points out that the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered, (#2357).

Inasmuch as they are contrary to the natural law, closed to the gift of life and void of true and affective and sexual complementarity, they cannot be approved.

The Catechism further states that homosexual persons are to be received with respect, compassion, and sensitivity, and without any unjust discrimination.

The Cardinal refers to the Document of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, “Considerations Regarding Proposals to Give Legal Recognition to Unions between Homosexual Persons” #10, which states that Catholic politicians must never accept the legalization of homosexual unions, equating them with true marriage. “To speak of a homosexual union, in the same sense as the conjugal union of the married, is, in fact, profoundly misleading, because there can be no such union between persons of the same sex. In what regards the administration of justice, persons in the homosexual condition, as all citizens, can always make use of the provisions of law to safeguard their private rights.”

His Eminence laments the fact that the diffusion of such remarks by the Pope give the impression that the Catholic Church has changed its teaching on such fundamental and critical questions.
