BISHOP LUCIA'S MOST RECENT ANNOUNCEMENT: On Friday, 27 Nov. the Bishop wrote that with the upswing in Wuhan virus cases in CNY, placing further restrictions on portions of the Diocese, we must adhere all the more to the protocols that are in place, for the sake of protecting the faithful from contamination. More from the pulpit this weekend.

CHRISTMAS MASSES: Now, even Our Divine Lord's Nativity is going to be affected by this health crisis. Since the Mass of the Vigil of Christmas is the most popularly attended of all Christmas Masses, in order to accommodate all those who wish to attend, and yet maintain our 1/3 capacity limitation (please pray that this is not further restricted by our holy Governor before then), we will have two Vigil Masses for Christmas. Permission for this has been granted by the Bishop. The 4 PM Mass of the Vigil of Christmas (Thu 24 Dec.) will be for the A-M crowd (Group I). The 6 PM Vigil of Christmas will be for the M-Z crowd (Group II). Since we are not allowed to have our Choirs sing, there will be no Midnight Mass this year, and on Christmas morning, the 9:30 AM Mass will be the Ancient rite Latin Mass, and the 11 AM Mass will be an English Novus Ordo Mass.
