THE RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Words of Wisdom from Venerable Fulton J. Sheen

(Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen was for many years the Director of the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in the U.S. This is the Church's Missionary support organization. He is more widely remembered for his TV show in the 1950-60s, which was one of the most viewed programs in the nation. He was renowned for his wit, his wisdom, his ability to make the Faith so attractive. Here are some of his pearls):

“There are not a hundred people in the United States who hate the Catholic Church, but there are millions who hate what they perceive to be the Catholic Church.”

“Proud people think themselves to be better than they are, and when criticized always believe their neighbor is jealous or has a grudge against them. The humble know themselves as they really are, for they judge themselves as they judge time, by a standard outside themselves, namely God, and His moral law.”

“The essence of prayer is not the effort to make God give us something. Prayer, then, is not just informing God of our needs, for God already knows them. Rather, the purpose of prayer is to give God the opportunity to bestow the gifts He will give us when we are ready to accept them.”

“Every man rejoices twice when he has a partner in his joy. He who shares tears with us wipes them away. He divides them in two, and he who laughs with us makes the joy double.”

“God does not always spare the good from grief. The Father did not spare the Son, and the Son did not spare the Mother.”

“It is a terrible thing to fall into the hands of the living God, but it is a more terrible thing to fall out of them.”

“The Rosary is the best therapy for these distraught, unhappy, fearful and frustrated souls, precisely because it involves the simultaneous use of three powers: the physical, the vocal and the spiritual, and in that order.”
