THEY ARE AT IT AGAIN! RE-INTRODUCING THE 'EQUAL RIGHTS

AMENDMENT. The first time it was introduced, it failed to be ratified by the 38 states within 7 years of having been passed in Congress. Now the abortion activists are trying to revive it by removing the deadline for ratification by the States.
