GOOD FRIDAY: FAST AND ABSTINENCE

The law of fast obliges those between the ages of 18 and 59. It stipulates that only one full meal is taken on this day. Two smaller meals may also be taken, so long as they would not equal another full meal if taken together.

The law of fast is obligatory after one has reached their 14th birthday. It stipulates that no meat may be eaten on this day.

These penitential practices are undertaken in a spirit of sorrow for our sins, and to unite ourselves with our suffering Lord.
