Joseph Biden Forces us to pay for Abortions

In his proposed budget for fiscal 2022, Joseph Biden has eliminated, for the first time in 40 years, the Hyde Amendment, which prohibited the use of taxpayer dollars to fund abortions through Medicaid. The Hyde Amendment was passed in 1976, but was not implemented until 1980, after the Supreme Court upheld its constitutionality. It has been included every year since then in the appropriations bills of every administration, of either party, with bipartisan support. Prior to its enactment, US taxpayer dollars were funding approximately 300,000 abortions each year.

In addition, the proposed budget includes the following pro-abortion funding:

- The removal of the Dornan amendment which prevents appropriated funds (federal or D.C. Revenues) from being used to pay for abortions in the U.S. Capital district. This would mean that approximately 1400-1500 abortions would be paid for each year by the taxpayer.

- The removal of the Aderholt Amendment which prevents the FDA from approving the creation of genetic or creation modification to human embryos.

- The longstanding HIV-Notwithstanding Provision is altered allowing more funding for contraception, including abortifacients.

- Funding for the Title X family planning program increased to \$340 million dollars from \$268million that allows grantees to be collocated with abortion clinics and requires referral for abortions.

- Funding for Population Control Programs increased from \$575 million to \$583 million, which is a funding stream for organizations, both domestic and foreign, which promote abortion.

- Remove protections from the UN Population Fund, which required that it not fund abortions, such as China's one-child policy.

- Support for the creation of a so-called "public option" that covers elective abortion for a government run health insurance offered through the Affordable Care Act marketplaces.

- Replaces the Women's Global Development and Prosperity Initiative with the Gender Equity and Equality Action Fund and appropriates \$200 million for its activities.

The Biden-Harris administration is the most pro-abortion, pro-death administration that has ever been in office. Let us continue to pray that its illegitimacy may soon be uncovered and these evil people face justice for their wickedness.
