A LETTER FROM OUR MOST REVEREND BISHOP

On the table in the vestibule you will find a letter from Bishop Lucia that he has asked all pastors to provide for our parishioners. The letter is an update on the Chapter 11 Bankruptcy process that the Diocese has been working through since 2020. The priests of the Diocese met with the Bishop on Tuesday of this past week to hear from the lawyers and other officials of the Diocese about what is the next phase.

HOPE APPEAL REPORT

The Diocese has sent us the latest data on the 2022 HOPE Appeal. The Diocesan has received \$4,602,835 from 16,975 donors throughout the seven-county Diocese. In addition, it has received \$114,00 from parishes which did not make their assessment. So, in total, the Diocese has \$4,716,171.00 from the Appeal.

Our Lady of Good Counsel parish was assessed \$20,545.43 for last year's campaign, and \$21,320.00 was donated! So we reached 103% of our assessment. Out of the 118 households in the parish that were solicited, 99 responded. So God bless you, the good people of Our Lady of Good Counsel Church. We do not see many of the programs funded by the HOPE Appeal, nor do we receive any funding from it, but you people are so generous and committed to the Diocese, that you put us over the top. May God reward you in ways that only He can!

The UN and One World Government
from Bishop Athanasius Schneider

Question: Which ideological and political powers in the current historical moment do you consider the most dangerous for Christianity?

Bishop Schneider: There is ever more evidence for the establishment of a One World by the United Nations and ultimately by powerful Masonic organizations *which act behind the scenes* in order to politically implement the *novus ordo saeculorum* (the new world order), the Atheist One World Government. This One World Government reveals a clear ideological program which is substantially atheist, materialist, anti-Christian, and even blasphemous, with the totalitarian imposition of abortion “rights” and homosexual indoctrination, the climate change myth and the destruction of national identities through events like “The Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration,” the annual meetings of the World Economic Forum of Davos (Switzerland), for instance. In its program, the latter promotes the “global order”-as they call it-of “gender equality” under the acronym of “LGBT”. We know from recent history that interference and manipulation of language is part of the repertoire of authoritarian regimes.

Such a recognizably Masonic and atheistic One World Government is in the process of realizing the final stage of the Masonic-Communist plan. Against this real danger of a neo-Marxist and Masonic One World Government, those social and political organizations which have not yet been brought into line with the uniform thinking of the neo-Marxist and Masonic World Ideology, and have therefore retained their freedom of *thought* and action, should ring the alarm and start to organize a coalition of legitimate resistance, comprising all people with common sense in both the East and West and also in Africa and South Asia. The world urgently needs heroic and noble resistance fighters against the world dictatorship which enslaves people through the absurdity of gender ideology, the moral corruption of innocent children, and the genocide of unborn children.

(Bishop Athanasius Schneider is the Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of St. Mary in Astana, Kazakhstan. He was born in 1961 in Tokmok, Kyrgystan, USSR. He and his family suffered under the Soviets for their Catholic Faith, before they emigrated to Germany. He was ordained to the holy priesthood in 1982. At the age of 45, he was named a Bishop by Pope Benedict XVI. He is fluent in German, Russian, Portuguse, Spanish, Italian, English and French. He reads also Latin and Greek.)
