SOLEMNITY OF PENTECOST NEXT SUNDAY

With which the Easter season ends. The law of the Church requires that every Catholic who has made their First Holy Communion must receive Holy Communion at least once a year. Here is the exact wording of the Canon: "#920: Once admitted to the blessed Eucharist, each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. #2: This precept must be fulfilled during paschal (Easter) time, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year."

-As an aside: If you did not attend Holy Mass for the Solemnity of the Ascension without serious reason, you must not go to Holy Communion until you have gone to Confession to accuse yourself of neglecting the Holy Day of Obligation.

MARIJUANA: A RECREATIONAL DRUG?

Under the stellar governorship of Andrew Cuomo, NYS legalized marijuana as a "recreational drug", as have several other states. A reent study published in the 4 May edition of <u>Psyshological</u> <u>Medicine</u> has some interesting finds.

The study examined 6.9 million people ages 16-49 and more than 45,000 schizophrenia cases from 1972-2021. It found that the adjusted incidence risk ratio for males ages 16-20 was more than twice that for females of the same age group. Conclusion: "assuming causality, one-fifth of cases of schizophrenia among young males might be prevented by averting CUD (cannabis use disorder).

"Under the assumption of causality, in 2021, approximately 15% of recent cases of schizophrenia among males would have been prevented in the absence of CUD, in contrast to 4% among females...For younger males, the proportion of preventable CUD-associated cases may be as high as 25% or even 30%."

The findings add to a substantial body of evidence that marijuana use carries significant risks, both to the user, and to those around him, despite libertarian arguments that the issue is a "victimless crime" and a matter of personal liberty.

Dozens of studies have found a link between marijuana use and developing psychosis and schizophrenia, particularly when used in one's teens and early 20s, when the brain is still developing. States that have legalized marijuana have also seen increased deaths from traffic accidents.

Shortly after Colorada became the first state to legalize recreational marijuana in 2012, Sgt. Jim Gerhardt of Denver's North Metro Drug Task Force said he has "seen children infant age that have been getting into this stuff and hospitalized, and this has been under medical marijuana. I can't imagine how bad it's going to get with full-blown legalization."

<u>National Review's</u> Ryan Mills wrote about the case of Catherine Mulberry, a Minnesota honor student and varsity athlete who became addicted to pot as a teenager, was diagnosed with schizophrenia, and whose descent into psychosis led to harder drugs and an eventual overdose of fentanyl-laced methamphetamines. He also cites Dr. Robin MacGregor Murray of

King's College London, who agrees there is a link between cannabis and pyschosis, particularly <u>due to the higher potency of today's supply.</u>

In the US, marijuana uses is fully legal in 21 states, and decriminalized in an additional 10 states.
