NATIONS, BEWARE!
(cont'd from last week's bulletin)

(The following is a commentary on Psalm 2, by His Excellency, Bishop Richard Williamson. The Bishop is pointing out that the Psalm points to the rejection of Jesus Christ as King over all the nations of the earth, and the fateful consequences of that rejection).

V 7: "I will tell of the decree of the Lord: He said to me, "You are My Son, today I have begotten you.

V8: Ask of Me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession.

V9: You shall break them with a rod of iron, and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

The divine Father begets from eternity the divine Son, and once the divine Son is incarnate in human history, then He has only to ask, and the Father will give Him "all power in Heaven and on earth," (Mt. XXVIII.18).

Such power, that if men's sins make it necessary, not only the Ukraine, but all the world's nations could be smashed to pieces.

V 10: "Now therefore, O kings, be wise: be warned. O rulers of the earth.

V 11: Serve the Lord with fear, and rejoice unto Him with trembling.

V 12: Embrace discipline, lest He be angry, and you perish from the just way, for His wrath is quickly kindled.

V13: Blessed are all who take refuge in Him. The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom."

Modern man's scorn of God can have terrible consequences. But souls who rightly fear God have, even in 2023, nothing else to fear.

(We must beg the Mother of God to awaken the hearts of the people of this age to the rejection of God, of Jesus Christ and His Church, so that "the nations will not be crushed on the day of His wrath".)
