AN AMAZING COINCIDENCE

Last weekend, after telling the story of the Chinese girl who was killed for receiving the Blessed Sacrament Which had been thrown down on the ground by the Communists, I received an email from one of our parishioners. She told me that the priest in the account, who had been placed under house arrest, and could only watch the girl from his rectory-prison, was her great uncle! His name was Fr. John Baptist Palm, and he was the brother of her grandmother. She said that the story was very familiar to the members of her family. He had been ordained a priest in 1941, and entered the Jesuits in 1944, so that he could join the Jesuit China Mission. He went to China in 1948, and was stationed at Christ the King Church. He was arrested on 15 June 1953, and expelled from Shanghai on 26 July 1953, and that day, prior to leaving, he was allowed to bury the Chinese girl who had so reverently consumed the Sacred Hosts on the ground outside the church. He went from there to Taiwan, where he served at Sacred Heart Church in Hsinchu until 2003. Finally, he was brought to the Sacred Heart Jesuit Center in California in 2004, and he died on 8 September 2008.
