SINS THAT WILL SEND ME TO HELL

Msgr. Charles Pope gives us a list of the most common mortal sins. Understand that to be a mortal sin, there must be grave matter (what is listed here), full knowledge and full consent of the will.

Here they are listed under the Commandment which refers to them:

- I. Polytheism, Idolatry, divinization, magic, sorcery, spiritism, Atheism, agnosticism, Heresy, schism, stubborn refusal to obey God, recourse to Wicca, Pachamama, witchcraft, horoscopes, palm-readers, Ouija boards, crystals, mediums, psychics, pendulums, Reike, Charlie-charlie, seances.
- II. Blasphemy, cursing (wishing evil to another), unfaithfulness to promises, false oaths, perjury.
- III. Deliberate missing of Holy Mass on Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation without sufficient reason, doing unnecessary physical work, unnecessary shopping, engaging in sinful activity.
- IV. Negligence of obligations, responsibilities to parents or children, hatred, ingratitude, disrespect, disobedience, insubordination to lawful authority, undermining authority.
- V. Direct, intentional murder, abortion, euthanasia, suicide, hatred, anger, terrorism, seduction of another into serious sin.
- VI. Adultery, masturbation, fornication, incest, unnatural sex acts, sterilization, contraception, artificial/in vitro fertilization, divorce and remarriage, polygamy, cohabitation.
- VII. Theft, borrowing without permission, fraud, paying unjust wages, withholding wages, price fixing, taking advantage of another's ignorance or weakness, work poorly done, tax evasion, forgery of checks or invoices, excessive spending, willfully damaging another's property, failure to make restitution, greed.
- VIII. Lying about serious matters, depriving others who have the right to know of serious matters, false witness, rash judgments, detraction, violating the seal of Confession, divulging secrets.
- IX. Impure thoughts, looks, speech; viewing pornography, watching suggestive movies, shows or listening to arousing music, dressing provocatively.
- X. Jealousy, envy, ingratitude, greed.
